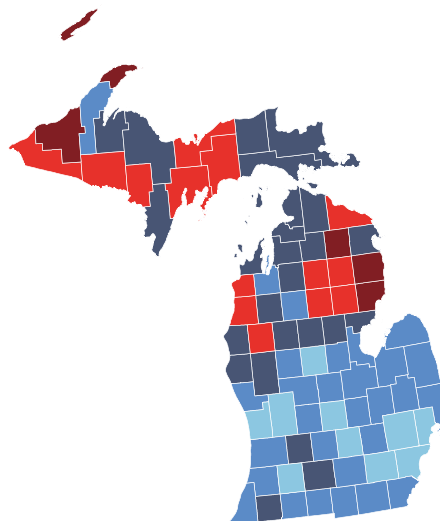

In 2014, 8,834 VA home loan guarantees were made in Michigan to support veteran homeowners. VA loans represented 4.6 percent of Michigan's home mortgage originations in 2014.
