MCA names state Rep. Hank Vaupel "Legislator of the Year"

State **Rep. Hank Vaupel,** R-Livingston County, has been named Michigan Community Action's (MCA) "2018 Legislator of the Year" for his contributions to his local agency, Oakland Livingston Human Service Agency (OLHSA), which supports people with programs that help them attain self-sufficiency.

The awards will be presented at MCA's annual "Day at the Capitol" in Lansing Thursday, **May 3.**The annual event will also recognize five outstanding CAA volunteers and five clients who made significant changes in their lives with the help of Community Action programs.

"Rep. Vaupel is committed to helping his community and the residents living in it," says **Kate White,** MCA executive director. "He has been a participant at many OLHSA events, such as Walks for Warmth, which help raise money for residents to stay safe and warm during the winter months. Rep. Vaupel is chair of the Health Policy Committee. He is also a member of the Insurance, Michigan Competitiveness and Tax Policy committees. He is a former Handy Township supervisor, secretary for the village of Fowlerville Downtown Development Authority, board member of the Fowlerville Area Fire Authority and serves on the Economic Development Council of Livingston County, as well as church council president at St. John's Lutheran Church.
