## **PNC Bank recognized for volunteer services**

PNC Bank volunteers were recognized for making positive changes in the lives of people in Northeast Michigan at the Michigan Community Action Volunteer Awards Ceremony at the Capitol in Lansing on April 30.

PNC Bank was nominated by Alpena-based Northeast Michigan Community Services Agency (NEMCSA) and is among 10 individuals or organizations honored from across the state.

PNC Bank was cited for its work with Head Start programs in Northeast Michigan, with volunteers donating more than 60 hours of their time to three of the Cheboygan Head Start sites and 100 hours at the Pinconning Head Start site. PNC granted funds to purchase computers, painted classrooms and buildings and started a project with children on learning how to save money.

Michigan Community Action (MCA) awards are given annually to clients who overcame economic and social challenges, and volunteers who go above and beyond to improve a community's welfare.
