Our Executive Director's role is to promote community action in Wisconsin to ensure compliance with public policy and program compliance. This includes visible and continuous advocating for state legislative funding and educating Wisconsin policymakers and the public on poverty and poverty issues. Part of this role is to also provide support, networking, and education to the member agencies on resource development and program management.

The ideal candidate will have a Bachelor's degree in business administration, political science or related fields and a minimum of 5-7 years of successful senior-level management experience. This experience should include public sector work in community activism type programs, within non-profits or public welfare organizations.

Previous experience with the political, legislative and governmental process and government funding for anti-poverty programs is required. Our Executive Director must be able to become a licensed Lobbyist in the State of Wisconsin by the Wisconsin Government Accountability Board and able to travel occasionally as needed for state and national conferences and visits to member agencies.
